

## OFFICE OF NAVAL RESEARCH VISIT REQUEST SUBMISSIONS

Due to the number of visit requests submitted to the Office of Naval Research, three (3) days processing time is required for all visit requests whether received via the JPAS or by FAX. A visit request is mandatory for all classified visits to the Office of Naval Research (ONR), regardless of the duration of the visit. Access to classified meetings at ONR will not be granted under any circumstance without a valid visit authorization request on file.

The Joint Personnel Adjudication System is the preferred method for submitting visit requests to the Office of Naval Research. Companies or organizations not on JPAS must fax a visit request to the ONR Security Division at 703-696-5126 on company or organization letterhead.
